CANADA SUMMER JOBS PROGRAM:

The parish recently was informed that it would not
receive funding to hire a summer student this summer.
The decision is based on the Liberal Government's
discriminatory attempt to override our Charter of rights
enshrined in the Canadian constitution. For the first time
in several years, our application was unsuccessful. We
have received information that dozens of parishes and
faith-based organizations across the country that declined
to "tick the box" or ticked the box and crossed out the
statement that referred to "reproductive rights" were also
unsuccessful. The consequence of this action on the part
of the federal government is that many parishes,
churches, and organizations will not have the benefit of
having a student for the summer. One of our core beliefs
is that human life, created by God, is sacred. For this
reason, we oppose the practice of abortion. Parishioners
