SACRAMENT PREPARATION PROGRAM 2020-2021

1. Children who are age 7 years and up (Or will be age 7 years by Dec. 31st.) can register for this year's Sacrament Preparation Program, which includes celebrating the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation, and First Eucharist. Registration forms are available on both parish web sites. Program cost = \$60 per child. The program begins in mid - October.
